Sunnyside Daycare

If you are interested and would like to send your child(ren) to our new daycare program on Pedagogical days please register for daycare with Heather Stratton. Cost of registration for Ped days only is \$15.00/child or \$20.00/family and the cost of daycare for each Ped day is \$16.00/student. Unfortunately the daycare will not be able to remain open on Ped Days if we do not have 10 students registered for these days. In order for the daycare to be open for the next ped days (November 18th & 25th) we will need to have at least 10 students registered by November 11th.

Parent/Teacher Night

This year we will be holding Student-Led conferences on Thursday, November 17th from 3:00pm until 7:00pm. Come in and see examples of your child's progress in term 1. Parents will be able to review and sign their child's IEP's at this time. Additional information will be sent home concerning the time of the conference. Dads in School

The purpose of "Dads in School" is to bring more men into school so they can better understand and support the work schools do to help children learn and grow. The program also gives us tips on how to make Sunnyside an inviting and comfortable place for fathers, especially knowing that some may have negative feelings about school from the past.

To ensure the safety of everyone at school, all volunteers must have a background check and parent volunteers are always working under the direct supervision of a teacher or other school employee. Already, over 20 men have signed up to spend a day in school with their child. This is a great way to show your child that school is important to dads.
