**Who qualifies:** Children whose parent or grandparent attended the majority of their elementary schooling in English in Quebec or Canada. Or if the child has a sibling who attended or attends an English school. Please contact the school for more details.

**The following services will be offered at Sunnyside Elementary school for the 2014-2015 school year;-**

- **Pre-kindergarten;** full-time bilingual services, five days per week from 8:00 – 2:30
- **Breakfast Program;** five days per week, variety of healthy foods prepared fresh daily. The cost for the breakfast program for each family per year is \$45 for the 1<sup>st</sup> child, \$25 for the 2<sup>nd</sup> child and the 3<sup>rd</sup> child eats free.
- **French** as a second language; **Kindergarten French immersion- 90%**, grade 1 to grade 6; 30% French. Teaching is based on best practices as a second language and in other subjects given in French. Preparing students to be bilingual in speaking, writing and reading. Qualified French mother tongue teachers.
- **English,** Language arts program that will prepare children to be fluent in speaking, writing, and reading. Qualified English mother tongue teachers.
- **Arts,** enriched program in visual arts, music including singing and recorder, dance, drama and photography.
- **Physical Education,** a comprehensive program in physical education to build fitness and healthy lifestyles. Noon hour sports including soccer, basketball, handball, floor hockey and cross-country skiing. Inter-school tournaments are held.
- **Technology for Learning,** Through the ELS, cycle 3 students use iPads as a regular part of the learning day and all students have access to computers for learning.
- **Homework Program,** available two afternoons per week for students in both cycle 2 & cycle 3.
- **School Library,** A significant investment in books has many new selections for students on their regular class visits to the library..
- **Special Education services;** full services to special needs students are available on-site supported by resource teachers, technicians and teacher aids. Professional services are provided by psychologist, speech and language pathologists, psychoeducators and spiritual animators when required.
- **Qualified Personnel,** Sunnyside teachers and support staff are trained in the latest techniques and educational practices
- **School Fees; to keep education affordable, Sunnyside charges only \$60** per student in consumable fees for the school year which include workbooks, agenda and any textbooks required.
